*According to the Massachusetts Lawyer Diary and Manual "In addition to date notes, observant Jews celebrate the second, seventh, and eighth days of Passover; the second, eighth and ninth days of Sukkot; and two days of Shavuot. All Jewish holidays begin at sundown, the evening prior to the day of the holiday".

**Due to the lunar calendar these are only approximate dates.

***Under G.L. c. 4, § 7, cl. 18, legal holidays that fall on a Saturday are observed on that day.

****Under G.L.c. 4, § 7, cl. 18, a legal holiday shall be observed the day following when said holiday shall occur on Sunday.
